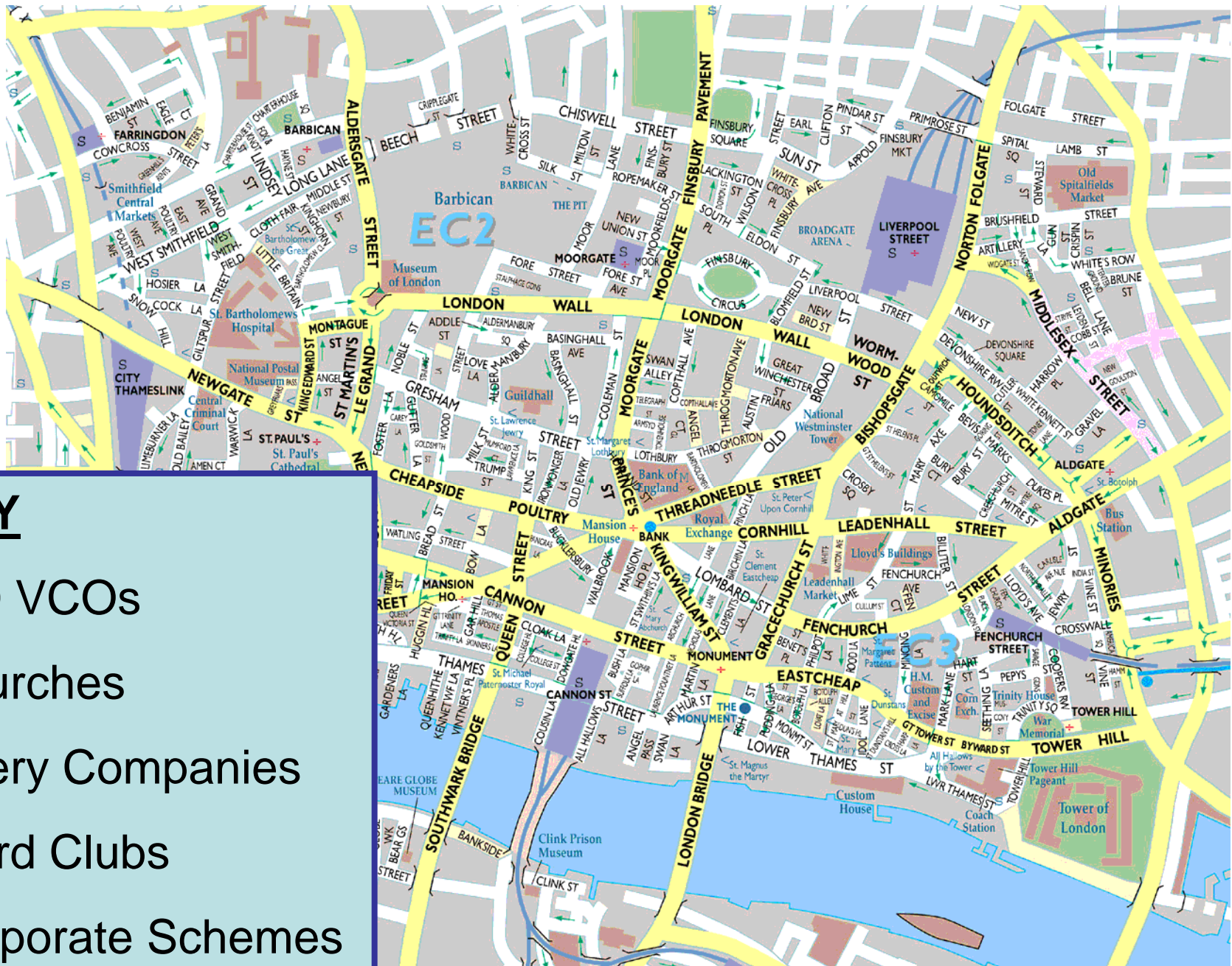

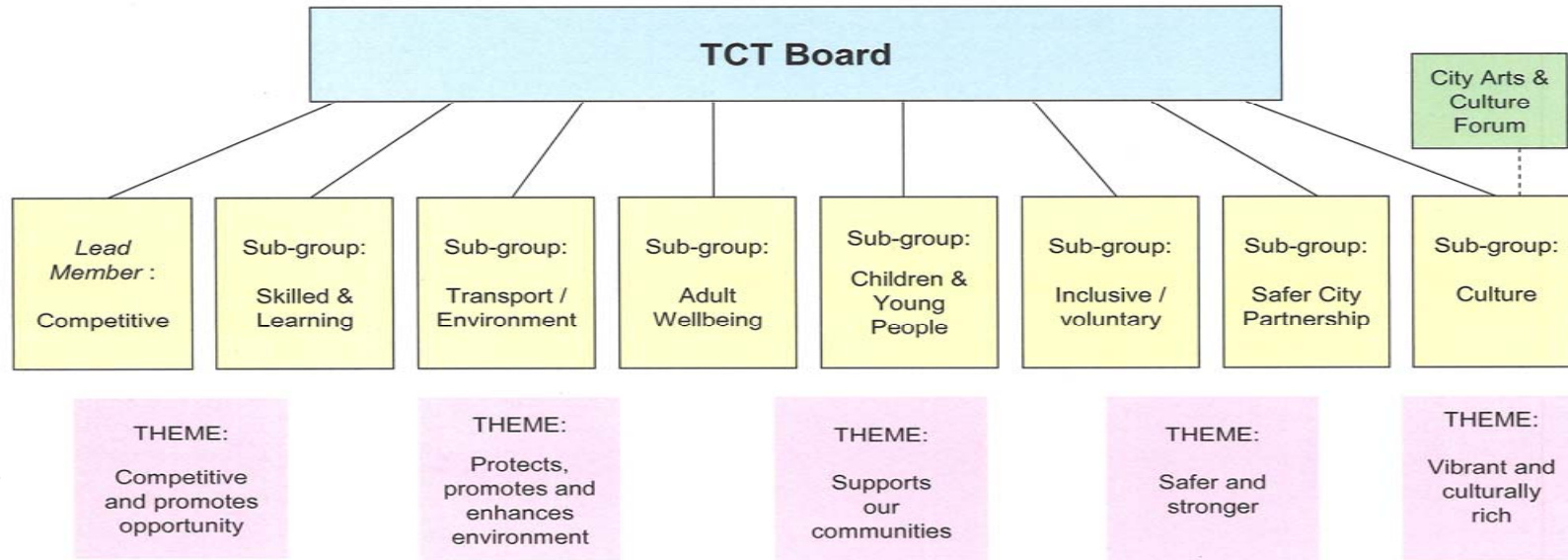

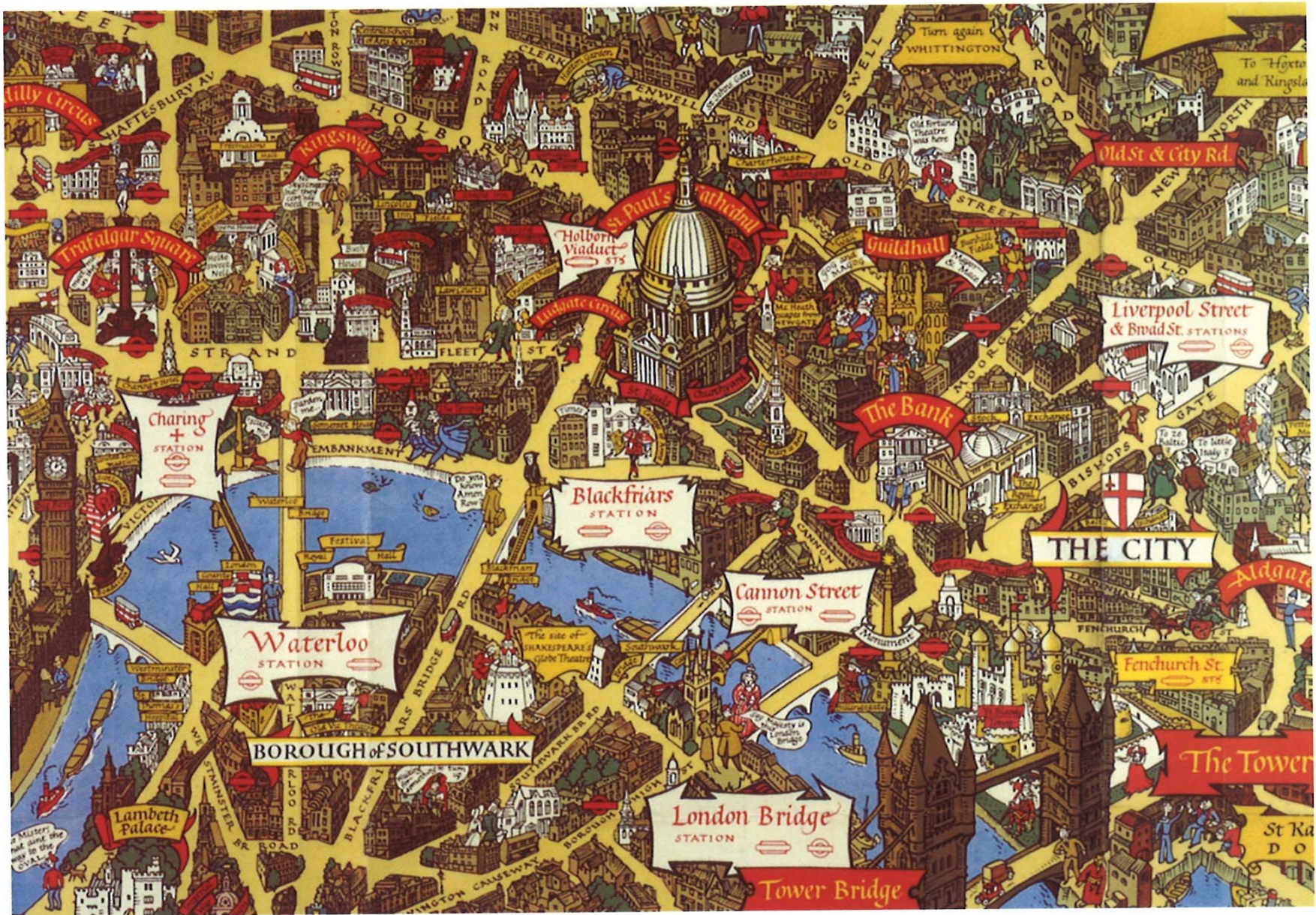

It is no longer possible or advisable to rely on one type of income.

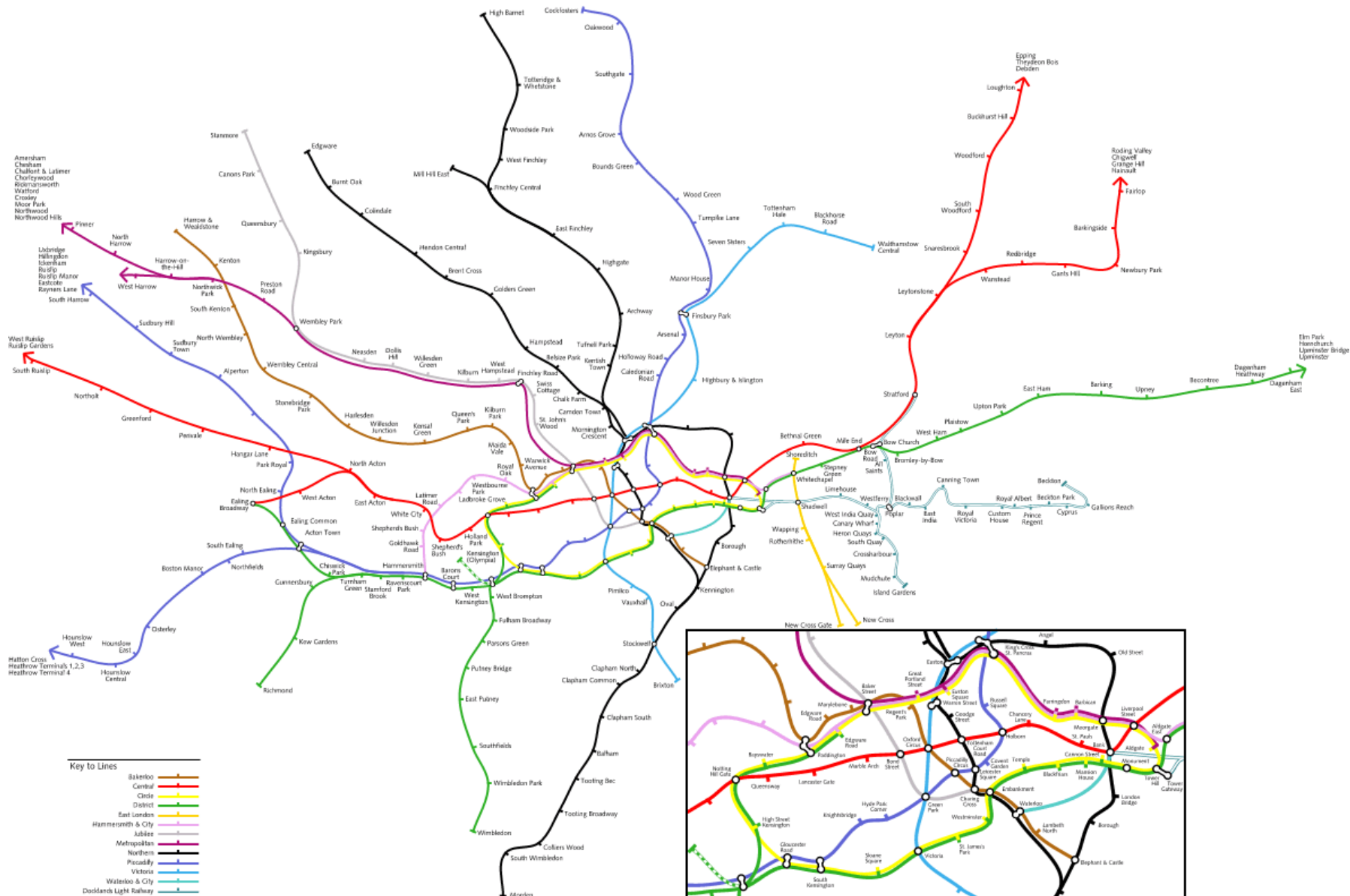
